4	<p><u>Quesito</u> <i>La/Il candidata/o fornisca una risposta adeguata, sulla base delle proprie conoscenze.</i></p> <p>The agreement on the student Visa between People's Republic of China and Italian Republic, coming into effect October 2, 2006, established the official framework for the registration of the Chinese students into two separate contingents both for the Marco Polo and Turandot programmes.</p> <p>This agreement, with a property simplification referring the procedures, allows the Chinese students without any knowledge of the Italian language to obtain the student Visa in order to attend the University Courses.</p> <p>The basic condition is that they have to subscribe to one of the established Italian course, preparatory for the matriculation and organized by the universities, AFAM institutions or their private affiliated institutions. The Turandot programme is specific for the AFAM institutions.</p> <p>What does the Turandot program foresee? How does the preregistration process take place for the specific students? What is the process that the Chinese students have to follow in order to be admitted to the AFAM institutions such as effective students?</p>
